






The 50 Plus Group's focus is 'Fun and Fellowship'. They usually meet on the third Thursday of the month, from 2.00–3:30pm. Everyone is welcome (if you're over 50 that is!!!!). Each meeting includes some praying, singing and Bible reading, and a talk from a visiting speaker.



Lunch Plus is a new initiative taking place at All Hallows Church for those over 50. We have a simple lunch of soup and sandwiches, a short mid-lunch speech, and then tea and cake to finish. All for a cost of just £3. Speak to the vicar or see the website for further details.



Café at the Church

This is a chance to relax, have a cuppa and chat with friends old and new.

It takes place on Fridays, 10:00-12:00 in the Church Foyer at All Hallows.



Ladies' Night usually takes place on the 2nd Thursday of a month, between 8:00-9:30pm.

There is a varied programme of events that take place. See the church website for further details.

We have a number of home groups at both All Hallows and St Philip's churches, which usually meet on every other Tuesday or Wednesday. They are good opportunities to build support with other people and to share Christian discipleship.



Men's Breakfasts take place on the 1st Saturday of the month, most months, from 8:15 to 9:30. They are an opportunity to enjoy bacon or sausage butties, spend some time with other blokes and share some time studying the Bible together.



The Alpha Course explores the basics of the Christian faith. Topics include Jesus, Faith, and the Bible, with opportunity to discuss your own questions too These courses usually run after the summer holidays, but other short courses can be made available throughout the year. Speak to the vicar if you are interested.



This is a 6 session parenting course for parents who want to do the best job that they can in



bringing up their children. It gives parents the opportunity to share their experiences, learn from each other and explore some essential parenting principles. Check the church website for dates of when a course is available.
