




We also take safeguarding very seriously and ensure that our volunteers have had the proper DBS checks before they are allowed on team.


If you would like to try out any of these events then do come along. We would love to meet you.

Sunday Groups

Every Sunday morning we provide age relevant teaching and worship for our children.



Parent And Toddler Church

This is for pre-school children and their parents / carers. It takes place from 10:00 - 11:30 Wednesday mornings, term time, at All Hallows Church Hall. It costs £1.50 per family.

Toddler Group

We have a toddler group on a Thursday afternoon too. We are aware that different children have different sleep patterns. It takes place from 1:00 - 2:35 Thursday afternoons, term time, at St Philip's Church Hall.



Who Let The Dads Out is for dads, male carers and their toddlers. It takes place once a month (most months), on the 3rd Saturday morning, 9:00 - 10:30, at All Hallows Church Hall. It costs £2 per family, which includes a bacon butty and fresh coffee.



Fun, games, quizzes, craft, tuck & Bible stories. Explorers is for 7-11 year old, 6:30 - 7:30 Thursday evenings term time, at All Hallows Church Hall. It costs £1, including tuck.

This is a children's club for those in years 3-6, taking place from 6:30 - 7:45 Friday evenings, term time, at St Philip's Church Hall. It's full of lots of fun activities with a short talk or video to help us think about something important.



Covies is a youth club for those too old for Adventurers, in years 7+. It takes place on Friday evenings from 7:30 - 9:00 term time, at St Philip's Church Hall. It is full of activities including snooker, pool and other sports.



This is a youth club for those aged 11-17, with lots of great things to do and space to meet up together. It takes place from 7:30 - 9:00 Friday evenings, term time, at All Hallows Church Hall. It costs £1.



This is a 6 session parenting course for parents who want to do the best job that they can in bringing up their children. It gives parents the opportunity to share their experiences, learn from each other and explore some essential parenting principles.
